

Recommended Vaccine Schedule

Our vaccine schedule differs slightly from the CDC\ACIP recommendation

<u>Age</u>	<u>Vaccine(s)</u>	<u>Interval</u>
Birth	Hep B	NA
2 Month	Pediarix, HIB, PCV13, Rota	8 weeks – 6wk minimum
4 Month	Pediarix, HIB, PCV13, Rota	8 weeks – 6wk minimum
6 Month	Pediarix, HIB, PCV13, Rota	8 weeks – 6wk minimum
9 Month	No shots unless catching up or Flu shot – Hgb & Lead screen	
*12 Months	ProQuad	Age dependent – not before birthday
*15 Months	Dtap, HIB, PCV13	6mo interval since last dose of the same
*18 Months	HEP A	May be given as early as 12mo
*24 Months	HEP A	6mo minimum interval between dose 1&2
30 Months	No shots unless catching up or Flu	
4 Years	Kinrix, ProQuad	Age dependent – not before 4 th birthday
*10 years	Tdap	Every 10 years here after
11 Years	HPV & Menactra	HPV 3 doses – repeated at 2 & 4 months
16 Years	Menactra & MenB*	MenB is a series - interval dependent on vaccine given

Combination Vaccines

Pediarix: Dtap, Polio, HepB

Kinrix: Dtap, Polio

ProQuad: MMR, Varicella

Pentacel: ~~Dtap, Polio, HIB~~ - not presently used in the office

Specific Dose Intervals

	HPV (Gardasil) – 3doses - 1st, 2nd in 2mo, 3rd 6mo after 1st dose
MCV4	Menactra – 2 doses, 8wks apart – booster after age 16
MenB	Trumenba – 3 doses 1st, 2nd in 2mo, 3rd 6mo after 1st dose
MenB	Bexsero – 2 doses 1 month apart
	Hep A – at least 6 months apart
	Hep B – 3 dose minimum - 1st, 2nd in 2mo, 3rd 6mo after 1st dose
	Dtap – 6week minimum between doses

MenB* is not yet required - education to be provided and vaccine offered
